He is a member of English Heritage's Advisory Committee and the CABE/English Heritage Urban Panel. He was elected to the Policy Council of the Town and Country Planning Association in 2010. Since 2003 he has served on a number of Panels and Committees of the Commission for Architecture and the Built Environment (CABE), including its Ecotowns Design Review Panel, its Planning Advisory Committee and its Regional Committee (representing the East of England). He is a member of the Academy of Urbanism and is a Past Chairman of the Historic Towns Forum.
